Martha Russo has been an Administrative Judge with the Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB) since January 2017. Prior to joining the MSPB, Judge Russo spent approximately twelve years as an attorney for the District of Columbia office of the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights, most recently as the Deputy Chief Attorney. She practiced general commercial litigation for four years before her government employment, at Baker Botts, LLP, in Houston, Texas and Hogan & Hartson (now Hogan Lovells), in Washington, D.C.

Judge Russo earned a B.A. in Philosophy at Tulane University and an M.S. in Logic & Computability at Carnegie Mellon University. She then earned a J.D. from the University of Texas, where she served on the editorial board of the Texas Law Review.
