Judge Yehl joined the U.S. Merit Systems Protection Board (MSPB) in its Central Regional Office in Chicago in September 2015. In 2019, he transferred to the Dallas Regional Office.

Prior to his tenure with the MSPB, Judge Yehl served on active duty as a U.S. Army Judge Advocate from 2004 to 2008, with assignments as Trial Counsel/Administrative Law Attorney with the U.S. Military Entrance Processing Command (USMEPCOM) in North Chicago, Illinois, and with the 3rd Infantry Division (Mechanized), in Fort Stewart, Georgia. He left active duty in 2008, and following a stint in the private sector, joined the Federal civilian workforce as a Labor Counselor with USMEPCOM in January 2011. In May 2014, Judge Yehl accepted the position of Associate Regional Counsel (Personnel and Ethics) with the Defense Contract Management Agency in Arlington Heights, Illinois.
