PETITIONS FOR REVIEW

- · Petitions for Review (Board)
 - Approximately 1,000/year historically
 - Lower receipts (approximately 600/per year) during lack of quorum/early restoration of quorum period (FY 2017 FY 2022)
- · Federal Circuit/Other Courts of Appeal
 - Whistleblower cases can go to any court of appeal
 - Mixed cases (discrimination allegations) go to district courts


- March 4, 2022 March 31, 2024
